Jerome Sellner
1931–2010

Jerome Vinet Sellner entered the spiritual world on November 26, 2010. A life-long devotee of the New Church, Jerome gave dedicated service in the military and the Federal Bureau of Investigation. From 1974 to 1987 he served on the board of the Swedenborg Scientific Association, and became its secretary in 1983, retiring from this use in 1995.

Jerome had a deep sense of the mission of the SSA, an organization that, though incorporated in 1906, became active in the work of Swedenborgian scholarship when its journal, *The New Philosophy*, was first published in 1898. During his thirteen years as secretary, Jerome gave the organization stability through his steadfastness to its mission and skill as a secretary, and provided an historical record of its life that is highly prized. For this the association is deeply grateful.
