Translators Conference 1992

It seems appropriate to announce in these pages the upcoming Translators Conference 1992. The last one, which was the first, was held in the tricentennial year 1988 and, as I recall it, we were determined at that time to repeat this event, if possible, every four years.

Sponsored jointly by the Academy of the New Church College and the Swedenborg Foundation, the 1992 Conference is to be held from the 23rd to the 26th of August at the Swedenborg Library, Bryn Athyn. An opening reception will be held at Glencairn.

The subject of this meeting as shown on the registration form is "The Neo-Latin of Emanuel Swedenborg," and as the reader will see, the topics chosen by the individual speakers highlight Swedenborg as a prolific writer of the Neo-Latin epoch.

The Latin language used in the latter middle ages and still current beyond the lifetime of Swedenborg—roughly 15 centuries after the classical period—was a far cry from classical Latin, even though all students in his time thoroughly studied the classics. Swedenborg's and his contemporaries' Latin was actually a spoken language that strongly drew on the concepts and nuances of contemporary European tongues.
