

EDITORIAL REMARKS

In this issue we have included the foreword to the new edition of *Psychological Transactions* together with the Acton preface to the first edition to which has been added footnote material reflecting some further insights into this collection of small works. In addition, a new table of contents has been prepared. The Reverends Woofenden and Goodenough are principally responsible for the scholarship that the new foreword and footnoting represents. On the cover of this issue of *The New Philosophy* is a copy of Swedenborg's manuscript title of one of the works in *Psychological Transactions and Other Posthumous Tracts*—the new title for the forthcoming SSA publication.

Professor Baker's reflections and observations on probability from a physicist's perspective complements Professor Ebert's paper published in our last issue written mostly from a mathematical viewpoint. Adding to these papers is Mr. Dewey Odhner's letter. Mr. Odhner is at present a graduate student in theoretical physics. In a later issue we shall be presenting some reflections on the same topic as they appear in some aspects of biology, geology and chemistry.
